School Gala – Get Involved!

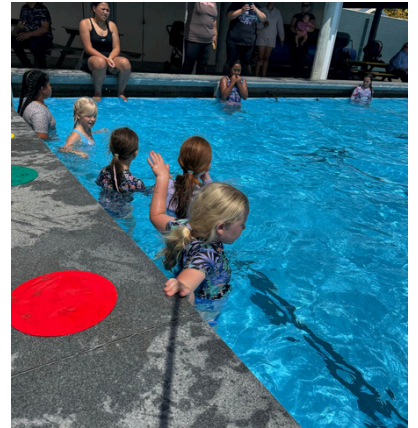

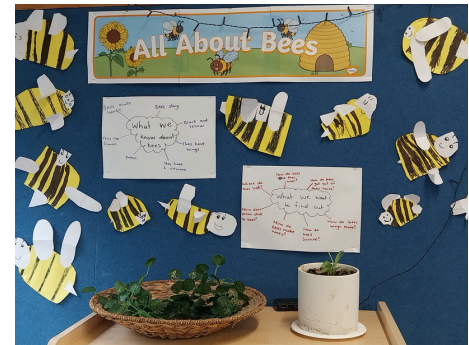
